Planning for Paper Decorations

Make pom poms - buy tissue paper from Pom Pom Love on Etsy - http://www.etsy.com/shop/PomLove

Make flag banners - R is for Riley and glue on to ½ - white ribbon

Make circles to glue on flag banners and glue on lettering – count your letters

Make toothpick scallop circles flags for cupcakes with smaller circles printed with initial

Make toothpick flags for appetizers – use leftover pieces of paper

Make beaded toothpicks

Make Tree with frame for thumbprints

Make paper cones on a stick for popcorn cones –double sided paper 12x12 and tie with ribbon

I used double stick tape to form the cylinders and then used regular tape to the bottom of cone

Make thank you for coming scalloped circle for cookie bags and punch hole for ribbon

Make little flags to line around a cake pedestal

I used double stick tape to tape it on to the cake pedestal

Make round scalloped tags with round interior initialed circles for inside scallop and punch hole for ribbon for drink glasses

Make 2-inch baby blocks out of wood and paint

Make numbers for baby food game

Print Baby babble game – see template you can print

Print pieces of ballot paper for baby food game – see template you can print

Sharpen pencils (bought light blue ones at Michaels)

Make sugar cookies and put in bags with ribbon to take home

Wrap styrafoam box or floral blocks stand for the pop cakes

Wrap box with stand for the suckers (bought at Michaels)

Tie ribbon under cake pop and make it look like a rattle

Wrap plants for winners

Set up table with thumbprint tree and then re-set up table for thank you cookies

Set up scrapbooking table – scrapbook and extra pages, stickers, paper, scissors, glue stick, pens

Glasses- tie a ribbon and scalloped circle around fluted wine glasses

Napkins

Serving plates or paper plates for food

Get all serving pieces needed for the food

Beads for toothpicks

Wood dowels for popcorn cones on sticks

Duck cookie cutter

White duck tape for scalloped circles on toothpicks

Blue and white pearls to decorate cupcakes

Blue suckers (in baby shower section)

Shortbread stamp

Cellophane bags for cookies

Ribbon for glasses, thank you bags, popcorn cones, cake pops

I used a 12-inch piece for glasses, popcorn cones and cake pops, and an 18-inch piece for thank you bags

2 Inks for thumbprints

Scallop press for cupcake pick decorations (brand name Recollections)

Circle press for interior of scalloped circles

Frame for thumbprint tree

Get a 6x4 frame for Welcome Baby Riley for buffet table – use one around house?

Paper Store Try to find 4 coordinating double sided decorated 12x12 pieces of paper

Make circle banners to hang from ceiling and thread fishing line with needle and string circles together Make flag banners – R is for Riley (at least 11) plus more for banner

Cut paper circles to go inside large banner

Cut letters out for big banner

Paper for scallop circles for cupcakes, drinks, and thank you cookie bag

Use leftover paper to make toothpick flags

Paper for popcorn cones – I cut a 12x12 piece of paper into fourths

Small flags for putting around pedestal cake stand

Paper for baby game numbers and instructions – cut out 5 scallops for numbers and one larger one for directions

Paper to wrap 2 plants for winners of games

Paper to wrap around sucker box

Paper to wrap around cake pop box
